CAMP OVERVIEW

We have an awesome Summer Camp planned for you with weekly themes! Additionally, weekly themed field trips occur on Friday's. Parents are responsible for transporting their child to and from the field trip locations. A welcome letter will be sent out prior to the start of each session with details regarding the sign-in process, activities, lunch, and everything else you will need to know.

There is a maximum 8:1 ratio of campers to Camp Counselors. Kids will be grouped together based on their age. They will stay with the same group all week. Each group of kids will have a designated Camp Counselor that will accompany them to each station, such as arts and crafts, a tennis lesson with a tennis pro, group games, and snack time with healthy snacks to keep them moving!

A swim test is administered on Monday of each week to evaluate each child's swim level. Camp Counselors will stay with their groups during free swim. Lifeguards are always on duty during free swim.
